Admission Procedure

- One passport size latest photograph of the ward affixed on the form.
- Original copy of birth certificate/ Extract of part II order along with one Photostat of the same (class-I)
- Original Transfer Certificate duly counter signed, Dependent Card & Progress Report of the previous school. (II-XII)

Evaluation Test

The evaluation test (when held for admission of TC cases other than from another APS) will cover the following subjects. (According to Article 200 of AWES 25 March 2019).

<u>Level</u>	<u>Subject</u>
Class II-V	English, Hindi & Mathematics
Class VI-VIII	English, Hindi, Mathematics & General Science
Class IX-X	English, Hindi, Mathematics & Science

NOTE:-

- Minimum qualifying marks is 50% in Evaluation Test for admission
- Age Criteria as per CBSE/AWES norms strictly applicable.
